1.1 Product Introduction

The 4-Port USB 3.0 Mountable Industrial Hub is design for USB connectivity in hush environment. Ready to take on 15K ESD, Fuse protection, and screw lock USB cable connection, this hub comes with mounting kit for mounting on wall or other accessible location. The Power input uses industrial standard terminal block with different DC power input for flexible power environment. The housing is made with industrial grade metal casing for strength and durability. With this USB Hub running at Super speed and UASP pass thru will greatly speed any data transfer.




Figure 1. 4-Port Industrial USB 3.0 Hub Layout




Figure 2. 7-Port Industrial USB 3.0 Hub Layout

Chapter 2: Getting Started

2.1 Hardware Installation




Figure 3. Wall Mount Plate Mounting

Mount your hub on the wall, if need. Use the provided Wall Mount Plate to mount the hub to the wall. See **Figure 3**.

- Connect the power adapter (not included) to the USB Hub. The power LED should light up solid. Supplying external power is optional, however to ensure each USB port is fully powered, connecting external power is recommended.
- 2. Connect the USB cable from the USB Hub (Type B port) to the host computer system.
- 3. The operating system should detect the Hub immediately and automatically install it.
- Once installation is complete, USB devices should be able to be connected to the Hub and recognized. The USB Link LED should
- Light up when a USB device is plugged in and detected.
